




- 560 Students

Growing Student Enrollment



- Santo ISD experienced 9.7% enrollment growth this year resulting in record high enrollment
- Housing outlook continues to see new construction with available lots to see 20-40 potential new homes per year
- Five year enrollment could reach 749 students fall 2027
- Ten year enrollment exceed 950 students fall
- Planning for 750 students should provide classroom for 4-7 years depending on the pace of construction
- 750 enrollment means that grade sizes would average around 55 per grade



Proposition 4

Passage of Prop 4 would reduce the Tax Bill on a \$200,000 home in Santo ISD almost 50%*

If the SISD Bond and Prop 4 pass in November, it is very likely the Santo ISD homeowner will pay a

lower school tax bill in 2024 than in 2022.


