

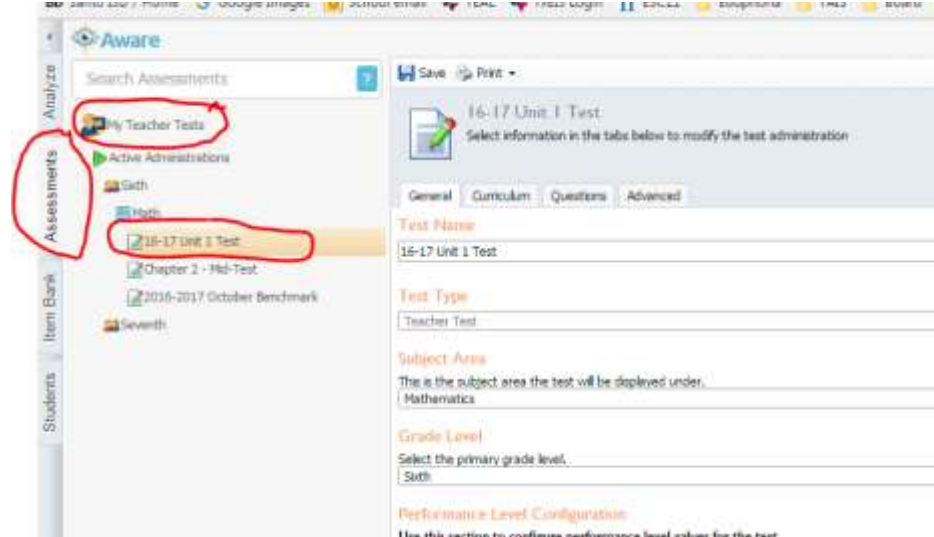
# Rescoring a Test in Aware

## Why would I rescore a test?

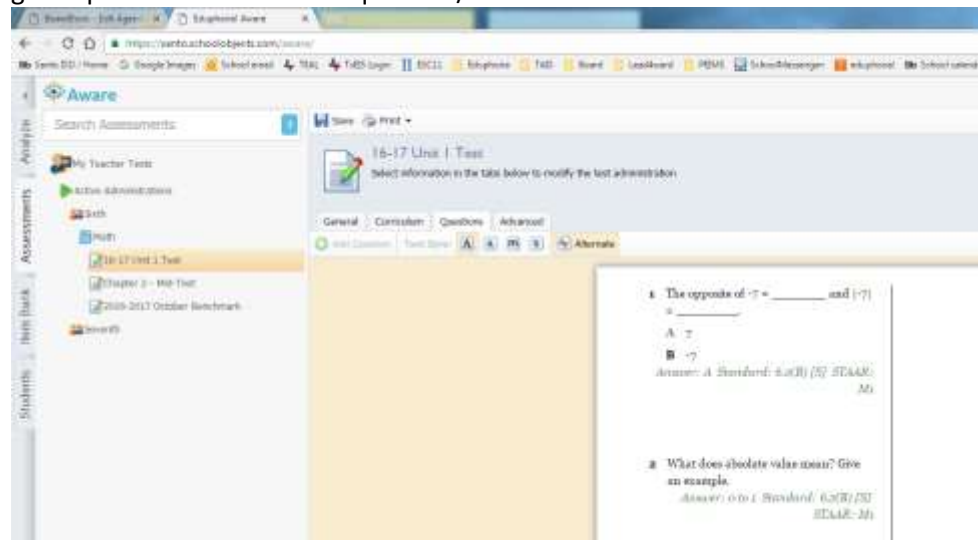
If you have already given the test to students and THEN discovered an error, it is an easy fix!

## How do I do it?

In Aware, pull up the test under the Assessments tab



Click on the Questions tab and find the question that needs to be changed. Hover over it and click on the green pencil icon to edit the question/answer



Change the answer as needed (change the answer choice on a multiple choice or type in the correct answer on a griddable, for example)
